




Action plan recommendations Building block 1: Support project pipeline



Action plan recommendations Building block 2: Administrative key topics



- Wide internal consultation (EUROSTAT, COMP, FISMA,... EIB, Commissioners incl. VP Sefkovik, Georgeva, ESIF gr.)
- Action plan presented to TTE Council on June 11th 2015
- Solvency 2 revised to incentivise investing in infrastructure (for institutional investors)
- Basel 3 under revision for investing in Rolling Stock, infra



State of Play and Follow-up

• EUROSTAT rules for PPPs revised: EU Guarantee through the EIB / EFSI will be considered as Private, EU funds as "neutral"; new guidance document http://www.eib.org/epec/resources/publications/epec

•EU study on permitting and procurement launched after scoping study to propose revisions/ best practices – reported in the Council

Document

 Simplification in procurement rules (Directive -> new IT framework), notably for Cross-border

•State Aids (for EFSI projects, Ports and Airports – new block Exemption to enter into force)
