**TARGET**: Sustainable Freight Transport Services (all modes, all EU regions)


**ECO-INCENTIVES**: Not linked to the financial deficits of an Action but to the actual external cost savings attained as a result of the Action (socio-economic and environmental merit -SEE merit-)

**EXTERNAL COST FACTORS:** GHG, air pollution, accidents, congestion, noise

**GOAL BASED APPROACH:** Aid proportional to the SEE



#### **FRAMEWORK:** Inserting eco-incentives






### **MAIN FEATURES:**

- MS as promoters (responsible for the design, implementation and budget)
- State aid rules applies
- Combining efforts from the EU and the MS financial support
- Not conceived as start up aids
- Monetized through common references (EC Handbook)
- Neutral on how the SEE merit is attained
- Funding conditional upon results

## ES PILOTS (RRF): MARITIME

### Target market: Motorways of the Sea (alternative to road)

- Eligible services: Intra EU SSS from/to Spanish ports
- Eligible units: ro-ro (trailers)

#### Goals:

- Improving environmental behavior from maritime transport
- Contributing to modal shift demonstrating a SEE merit

Merit incentivized: External cost savings by eligible units when using maritime services (€/unit)

- *Maritime (real): Vessel, fuel consumption, filters, engines, size, etc.*
- Road (average): Mix EURO IV-VI of the fleet

Beneficiaries: Road transport

State aid rules: compatibility through... art.93 TFEU! Budget: 60 M€



## ES PILOTS (RRF): RAIL

# Target market: Rail freight transport in the Spanish network Goals:

- Improving environmental behavior of rail freight transport
- Increasing market share of rail freight transport

Merit incentivized: External cost savings by eligible units when using rail freight services

- Rail (real): rail traction (diesel types and electric) and rail utilization rate (net over gross load (%))
- Road (average): Mix EURO IV-VI of the fleet

Beneficiaries: Railway undertakings

State aid rules: compatibility through Railway Guidelines (2008/C184/07)

Budget: 60 M€



#### **GOING FORWARD:** Potential role of eco-incentives

**GREEN DEAL:** Rewarding transport services to help meeting the deal

**TEN-T REVISION:** Including eco-incentive schemes as projects of common interest

**EU FUNDING:** Co-financing global impacts (GHG reduction)

**STATE AID RULES:** Standardization and revision
